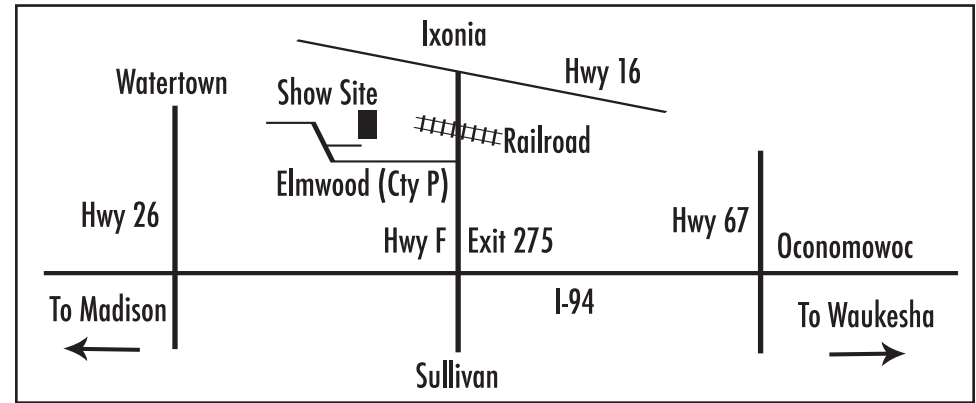

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

(Note: additional information required on back of form)

NOVICE CLASS: (The Novice class shall be divided into Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes). This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the times entries close have not won there (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: (The Open class shall be divided into Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes). This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the (3rd) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more junior handlers competing in the Open Class.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: The junior handler placed first in each of the regular Junior Showmanship Classes, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class at this show, shall automatically be eligible to compete for this prize.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES – OFFERED SATURDAY MARCH 3rd ONLY

The Sweepstakes is open to dogs and bitches, who, on the day of the show, will be 6 months and under 18 months of age. Puppies must meet with all other AKC requirements of eligibility. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entry Completion/Fees

ELECTRONIC ENTRIES ARE NOT ACCEPTED!!!

Entries will not be accepted after the closing date, without correct signatures, without correct entry fees or if they are illegible.

The AKC Agreement and Rules must be on the back of the entry form.

Owners are responsible for any errors in making out their entry forms. No refunds will be awarded for said errors or for duplicate entries.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing (email acceptable) or by telegram only prior to the closing of entries.

Checks and money orders must be payable in U.S. Funds and made out to **GMNEA**. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The club will add a \$20.00 collection fee to each returned check.

No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

No refunds for bitches in season.

Judging

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

Dog not required for further judging will be excused.

Space for un-entered dogs will be provided at this show under the conditions specified in the AKC rules.

Grounds

All dogs must be on leash or in their crates when on the show grounds.

The show giving Club, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Parents are responsible for supervising their children.

Owners and Handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and children and maintaining the cleanliness of their grooming area.

No Smoking in the building.

No use of powder or chalk in the building.

No dogs may be left in the building overnight.

Absolutely no parking at the show sight over night.

Exercise dogs in designated areas. Clean up after your dog. Failure to do so may result in removal from show with no monies refunded.

I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance there to, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim: and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim or loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by the law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents or any other persons.

I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. - (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering: i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wire-haired); Collies (rough, smooth); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); Poodles (toy, miniature, standard); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best in Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record, and dogs, which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed.
