For those that order the Yearbook but do not plan on attending the National Specialty, orders will be filled and mailed after the specialty. Please order ahead - very few (if any) additional copies may be available for purchase at the National Specialty .

Please read carefully the following categories. There is a place in this Yearbook to showcase all of those great gray dogs. Note that NEAA members receive special pricing on ads for the Yearbook. To qualify, at least one of the owners of the advertised dog must be an NEAA member or have an application pending (received by the Corresponding Secretary).
