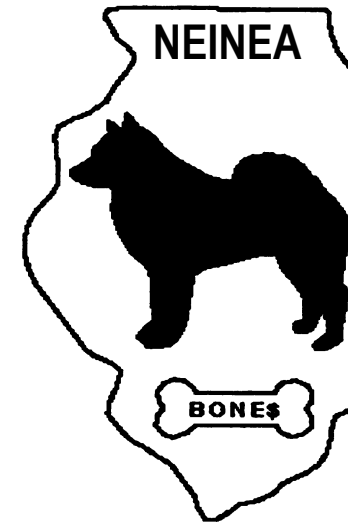

Note: Effective March 1, 1992, neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the Veterans classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competition beyond Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dog and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Stud Dog to be judged based only on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class. Fee is \$27.00 for the Stud Dog if not entered in another class; \$21.00 as an additional class.

Brood Bitch Class -Same as above, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. As the judge's decision will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry having been judged first will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, it's members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon this show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or injury, by caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering. i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid black, ASCOB, parti color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Daschunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired. Collies (rough, smooth). Bull Terriers (colored, white). Manchester Terriers (standard, toy) Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat). English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blemheim and Prince Charles). Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed competitions is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed requirements for championship.
- (Dog Show Class) consult the classifications in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog. i.e. age division, color, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been aquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of it's new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of aquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has recieved the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
